1. Purpose

Greening of special spaces like the rooftops of buildings (spaces that are difficult to be greened

encouraged, because it is highly effective for improving the urban environment, such as mitigation

of the heat island phenomenon, promotion of energy conservation, preservation of biodiversity, and

special spaces like rooftops to improve the urban environment and help realize an affluent urban life,

by honoring private companies, public organizations, individuals, and other bodies that have actively

attempted greening of special spaces and achieved excellent results.

Maintenance and management:

Is the maintenance technology creative? Is the maintenance adequate? Is the management after completion of the work well devised?

O Presentation:

Is the presentation well organized using reference materials, charts, or photos?

Presentations must be prepared in Japanese.
